



Dear Parent/Carer

Your child has completed a course of instruction under the Scottish Cycle Training Scheme and his/her performance is recorded in this certificate.

It is important that both you and your child recognise that the instruction took place under close supervision, either on relatively quiet roads (or in the playground). Therefore, this certificate should not be seen as a licence to cycle unsupervised on busy roads.

Learning safe road behaviour is an ongoing process, so it is important for you to make sure that your child keeps using the safe cycling skills learned during the training. Some notes may have been made about certain aspects of cycling that your child needs to practise more. It would be very important to make sure that your child is given as much help to continue practising the lessons taught on the course.

There are some useful website addresses in the parent's leaflet you should have received when your child registered on the course. Your local Road Safety Officer may also be able to provide you with further information on cycle safety.
