

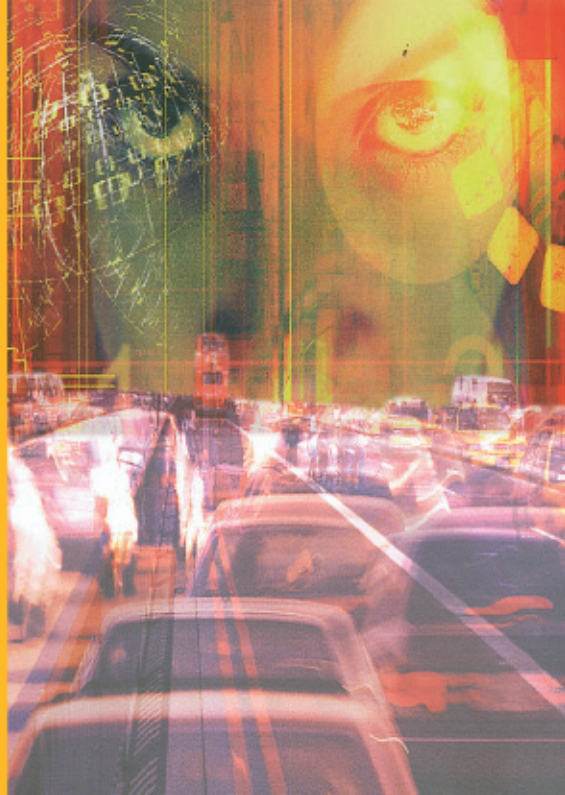

Working with you against Drugs



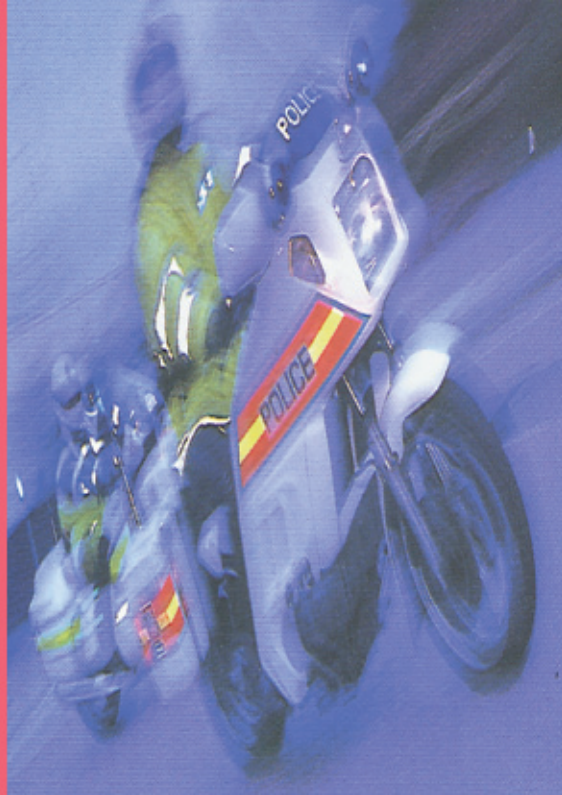
**If you drive any motor vehicle whilst under the influence of drugs, the police may stop you.**

**All Scottish Police forces have officers who are trained to detect drivers whose use of drugs has made them unfit to drive.**

## Is it worth mixing drugs and driving?

Drugs that impair your driving need not be illegal ones like ecstasy or cannabis. They can be products that are sold over the counter like some cough medicines.

Make sure you **know the score** about what you are taking. Remember if you have an accident it may not just be your licence that you lose!



It is an offence to drive a motor vehicle whilst impaired through the use of drugs and if found guilty you will be

- Disqualified from driving
- Fined up to a maximum of £5,000 or receive 6 months imprisonment
